

Blankets for babies



materials

- 2 coordinating pieces of fleece: 1 yard of each color/pattern
- Ruler
- Sharp scissors
- Optional: yardstick and/or masking tape

project instructions

- Cut the selvage edges off the fleece and make both pieces the same size. Make sure the length and width of the fleece is cut in whole inches. Lay fleece out with wrong-sides-together (pretty sides on the outside).
- Cut a 5 x 5 inch square out of each corner.
- Cut five inch slits, every one inch, to make a 1 x 5 inch fringe around the entire edge of the fleece blanket.
- Take the two layers of fringe and tie them together in a knot.
 - First, wrap the fringe around your finger.
 - Pull the end up and over the top of the fringe and push it through the loop.
 - Pull the end through.
 - Push up on the knot and tighten it, sort of like you would tie a necktie
 - Complete the above steps until all layers of fringe have been knotted.
